NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT THE COMPANY OF PROPRIETORS OF WHITCHURCH BRIDGE (the Company) has applied to the Secretary of State for Transport to increase the Toll Charges at Whitchurch Bridge.

Below are shown the current Toll Charges which the Company is authorised to demand and take, and the proposed Toll for which the Company has now applied under Section 6 of the Transport Charges &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1954.

Any persons having a substantial interest may, not later than 2nd January 2015 (i.e. within a period of 42 days from the first publication of this Notice), object to this Toll Application by giving notice in writing to the Secretary of State for Transport, c/o Julian Smith, Cities Policy & Delivery Division, Department for Transport, Zone 2/14, Great Minster House, 33 Horseferry Road, London SW1P 4DR, stating the grounds of their objection, and by sending a copy to the Company at the address below. - 1. Vehicles not exceeding 3.5 tonnes maximum gross weight 60p**
- 2. Vehicles exceeding 3.5 tonnes maximum gross weight £4.00**
